Following the success of our first year of bursary awards, we are delighted to announce

that we are now inviting applications for SSC Bursaries for the 2022/2023 season. Our bursary and race camp programme is run in partnership with Alpine Training Centre SCIO (formerly ATC) which is now a registered Charity, specifically set up to support young ski racers.

This season's Bursaries will focus on providing young ski racers with pre-season training in the Alps and winter training in Scotland.

The following activities will receive SSC Bursary support:

- October Camp / 2-weeks of pre-season glacier training (Full residential). Information on the camp can be found on the <u>ATC website</u>. A limited number of places are also available on this camp for non-supported athletes.
- Scottish Cairngorm Camps at Christmas, February and April (Training only)
- In addition, ATC will provide race support at key Alpine races (Pila, Bormio and Tignes) for SSC Bursary athletes. Note: Training only fees will apply for these camps.
- Bursary camps and activities are coached by the Alpine Training Centre SCIO who operate on a not for profit basis.

To gain the maximum training benefit we strongly recommend attending the October camp for a minimum of two weeks. The bursary will cover course fees on a fully residential basis at a value of £1500 per week, but does not cover equipment and transport / flights,

How to apply

The objectives of the bursary programme and criteria for selection can be found at www.scottishskiclub.org.uk and should be read prior to the submission of any application.

Applications should be submitted by 15 July 2022, using the SSC Bursary Application form which can be found at www.atccharity.com. Depending on demand and availability of funds, there may be an additional opportunity to apply in the autumn.

All applications will be considered by the SSC ATC Bursary Selection Panel and it is intended that bursary awards will be announced in late July or August 2022.
